## ***ENDANGERED SPECIES ON THE VERGE***

### **A Multi-Discipline Art and Stage Performance Contest**

**This exciting evening features 2D wall art and performance art:  
music and song writing, poetry, storytelling, stand up, dance and theater.**

**Purpose:** Artwork and performances must reflect the theme *Endangered Species on the Verge*. These include threatened or endangered vertebrate animals, amphibians, invertebrate animals, flowering- and non-flowering plants. The power of a positive approach to why it is important to ensure their protection must be presented creatively with the intent to educate and enlighten. No hate speech, profanity or nudity is allowed.

**Requirements:** Local and student artists who reside within a 60-mile radius of Flagstaff may enter. Students are encouraged. An artist statement is required with each submission. It must include 100-150 words explaining how your work portrays the chosen species.

Two dimensional wall art must be original and created by the submitting artist. It must not exceed 18 inches in any direction and must be framed and ready to hang. It will remain at Fire Creek Coffee Company throughout October. A 20% commission will be charged on any sold art work.

Performance art is limited to 5 minutes on stage.

**Entry Fee:** Artist \$20.00  
College Student \$15.00  
High School Student \$10.00  
Younger Student \$5.00

Entry fees will be shared between promotional costs, contest awards and the winner's choice of a wildlife charity. Cash awards will be given for 2D art and performance art. The winner of the 2D entries will be given a one year membership to Art35N, [www.art35n.org](http://www.art35n.org).
